Country Stone's rounded corners and varying edges give the appearance of being gently worn by weather and time, adding Old World charm to your modern landscaping projects. Unlike common stone that can slump, crack or crumble, Country Stone interlocking blocks will retain their beauty and strength for years to come. Country Stone allows you to create limitless design options for retaining walls less than 20" in height. Country Stone can also be built to border anything from seating walls, flower gardens and patios.

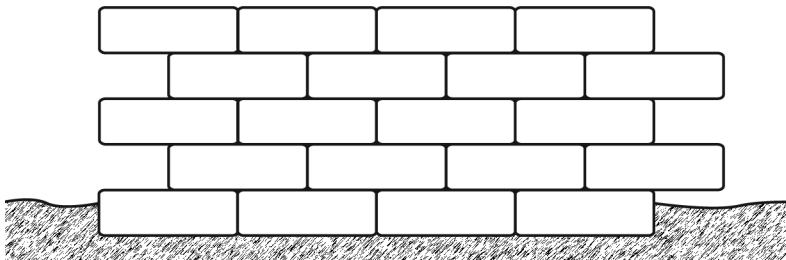
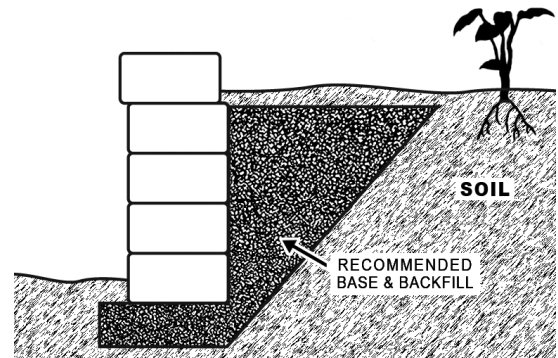

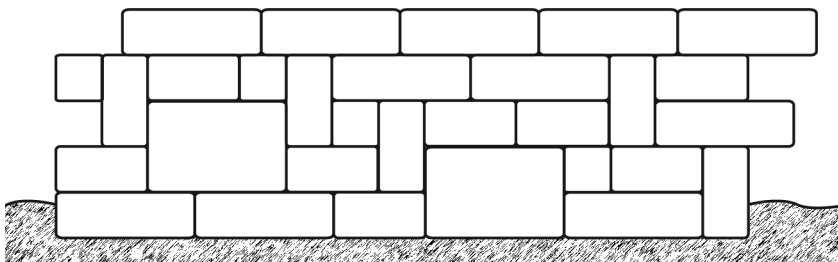

Installation:

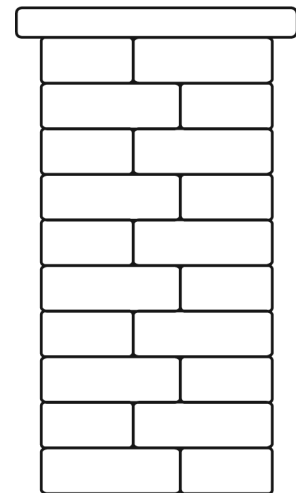
20" maximum wall height with 3" below grade for retaining projects. Base should be 14"-16" wide by 6" deep and well compacted. For base and back fill, use crushed stone (Type 2-A). Offset the vertical joints of units to maximize wall strength. When stones are stacked vertically on 4" side, another stone should be placed behind it to create an 8" wall thickness. Fabric can be used to separate clean gravel backfill from topsoil. Use masonry adhesive to adhere blocks.



Running Bond Pattern: 3 block per face foot.



Random Pattern: 3.36 blocks per face foot.
Each 20" tall x 60" section uses 28 stones.



Column:

- 4 Country Stone used per layer.
- Makes a 20" x 20" wide column.
- Glue with masonry adhesive.
